## The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Barston Village – Various Roads) (30mph Maximum Speed Limit and Revocations) Order 2025

The Council has made this Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, and all other enabling powers. The reasons for this Order can be obtained by written request from the address below; or by inspecting the documents at Solihull Connect, Library Square, Touchwood, Solihull during normal opening hours or via <a href="https://www.solihull.gov.uk/Roads-pavements-and-streetcare//Traffic-regulation-orders">https://www.solihull.gov.uk/Roads-pavements-and-streetcare//Traffic-regulation-orders</a> A copy of the Order is available upon request. Anyone wishing to question the validity or provisions of the Order should apply to the High Court within six weeks from the date that the Order became effective. The Order, which comes into force on 1 September 2025, will introduce the following:

## Maximum 30mph Speed Limit (to replace existing Maximum 40mph Speed Limit)

<u>Barston Lane</u> - From its junction with Eastcote Lane, in a westerly direction for a distance of 695m.

Barston Lane - From its junction with Knowle Road, in an easterly direction for a distance of 2472m.

<u>Eastcote Lane</u> - From its junction with Barston Lane, in a north easterly direction for a distance of 331m.

<u>Friday Lane</u> - From its junction with Barston Lane, in a north westerly direction for a distance of 427m.

<u>Knowle Road</u> - From its junction with Barston Lane, in a south westerly direction for a distance of 400m.

Oak Lane - From its junction with Barston Lane to its cul-de-sac end (entire length).

Ryton End - From its junction with Barston Lane to its cul-de-sac end (entire length).

Walsal End Lane - From its junction with Eastcote Lane to its cul-de-sac end (entire length).
