



## Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014

### Section 59

#### Public Space Protection Order (Chelmsley Wood) 2025

This Order is made by Solihull Metropolitan Borough Council ("the Council") under Section 59 of the Anti-social Behaviour, Crime and Policing act 2014 ("the Act").

THIS ORDER **PROHIBITS** the following things being done in the public space in the area shown outlined on the map attached to this Order ("the Restricted Area") and outlined in Appendix 1.

THIS ORDER **REQUIRES** specified things to be done by persons carrying on specified activities in the Restricted Area.

#### **IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

##### **1. Groups of three or more persons**

1. In the Restricted Area, between the hours of 6pm and 6am, an Authorised Person may require any or all of group of three or more persons, to leave the Restricted Area where he or she reasonably suspects that anyone within that group is causing, or is likely to cause, nuisance or disorder, or harassment, alarm and distress to any other person.
2. An individual, or group required by an Authorised Person to leave the Restricted Area is:
  - a. Prohibited from remaining within the Restricted Area which he or she is required to leave;
  - b. Required to leave that area immediately; and,
  - c. Prohibited from returning to the Restricted Area from which he or she has been required to leave within 24 hours of being required to leave.

#### Exemption:

A person does not breach clause c if he or she attends a bus stop within the Restricted Area so long as he or she is not accompanied by another person who has been required to leave the Restricted Area.

##### **2. Face Coverings**

1. In the Restricted Area an Authorised Person may require a person to remove a face covering where the face covering hides or partially hides the identity of the

wearer and the Authorised Person reasonably suspects the wearer is likely to cause, nuisance or disorder, or harassment, alarm and distress to any other person.

### 3. Bikes

1. Any person is prohibited from riding, cycling, or using an E-bike, E-scooter, motorbike or quad bike within the Restricted Area shown on the attached map. Unless:

- a. that person has a reasonable excuse to do so; or
- b. the owner, occupier or other person or authority having control of the land has consented (generally or specifically) to that person to do so.

Any person may push and walk alongside their E-bike, E-scooter or motorbike through the Restricted Area.

### 4. Interpretation

**“Authorised Person”** – means a police constable or police community support officer. An authorised person must be able to present his or her authority upon request.

**“Restricted Area”** – means the area of the Solihull Metropolitan Borough Council local government area delineated on the

# **Appendix 1**

## **Public Space Protection Order**

### **Proposed Prohibitions**

#### **Bikes**

Any person is prohibited from riding, cycling, or using an E-bike, E-scooter, motorbike or quad bike within the Restricted Area shown on the attached map. Unless:

- a. that person has a reasonable excuse to do so; or
- b. the owner, occupier or other person or authority having control of the land has consented (generally or specifically) to that person to do so.

Any person may push and walk alongside their E-bike, E-scooter or motorbike through the Restricted Area.

#### **Groups of three or more persons**

1. In the Restricted Area, between the hours of 6pm and 6am, an Authorised Person may require any or all of group of three or more persons, to leave the Restricted Area where he or she reasonably suspects that anyone within that group is causing, or is likely to cause, nuisance or disorder, or harassment, alarm and distress to any other person.
2. An individual, or group required by an Authorised Person to leave the Restricted Area is:
  - a. Prohibited from remaining within the Restricted Area which he or she is required to leave;
  - b. Required to leave that area immediately; and,
  - c. Prohibited from returning to the Restricted Area from which he or she has been required to leave within 24 hours of being required to leave.

#### **Exemption:**

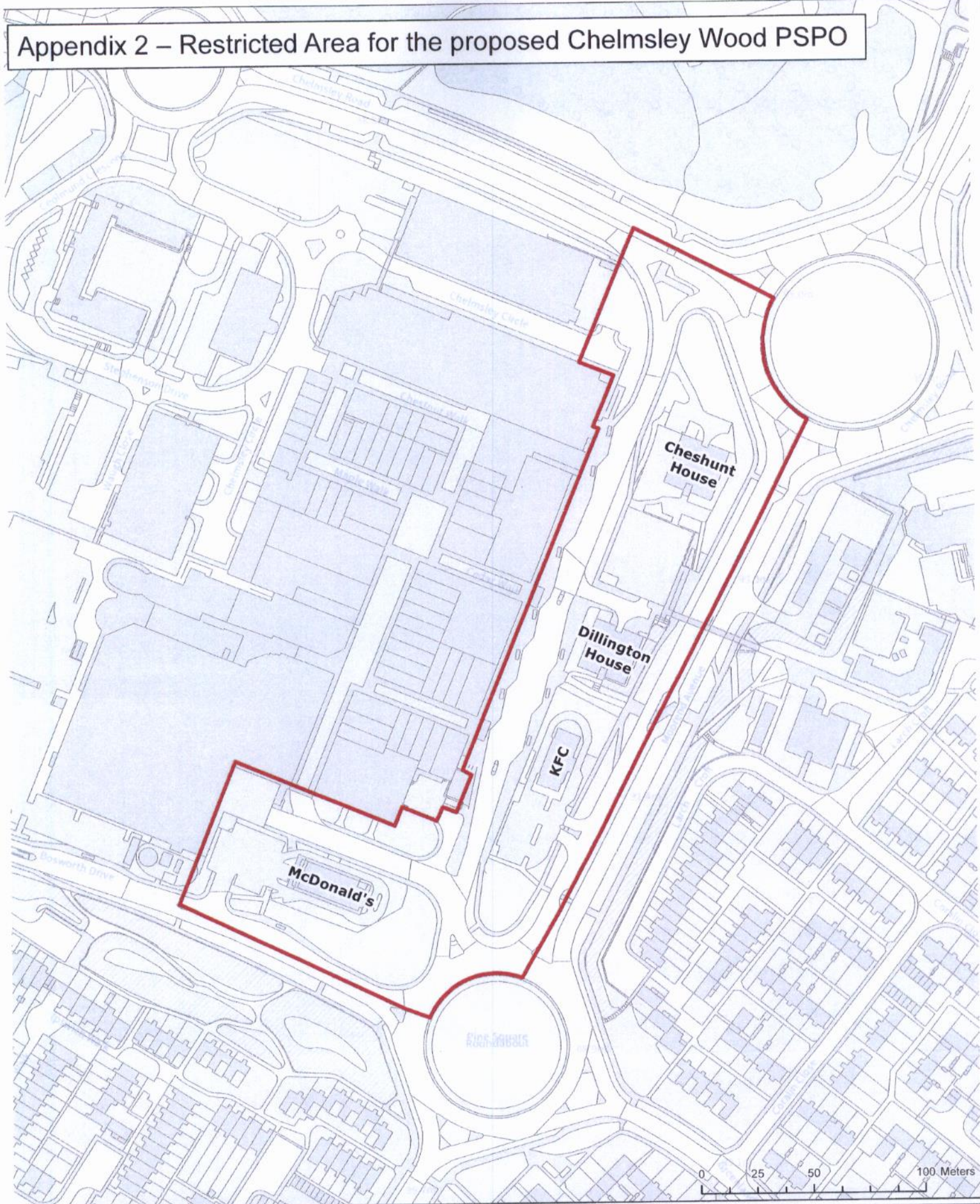
A person does not breach clause c if he or she attends a bus stop within the Restricted Area so long as he or she is not accompanied by another person who has been required to leave the Restricted Area.

#### **Face Coverings**

In the Restricted Area an Authorised Person may require a person to remove a face covering where the face covering hides or partially hides the identity of the wearer and the Authorised Person reasonably suspects the wearer is likely to cause, nuisance or disorder, or harassment, alarm and distress to any other person.
