Proposed Total Prohibition of Waiting (No Waiting at Any Time)

<u>Bryanston Road (both sides)</u> - From its junction with Streetsbrook Road Service Road, north-eastwards for approx. 28m.

<u>Streetsbrook Road Service Road (fronting 283 to 347) (both sides)</u> - From a point approx. 17m northwest of its junction with Bryanston Road, south-eastwards from approx. 93m to its southern junction with Streetsbrook Road.

<u>Streetsbrook Road (north-eastern)</u> - From a point 39m north-west of its junction with Beaumont Grove in a north-westerly direction for approx. 96m.
