Review of our Neighbourhood Plan

In a local referendum held on 6th July 2017 residents voted overwhelmingly in favour of the Hampton-in-Arden Neighbourhood Plan which was subsequently adopted by Solihull Council and is used mainly to inform the planning application decision making process.

It was originally thought that the Plan would be an important reference document until at least 2028 with the occasional minor review to reflect changing local and national requirements. However, the Governance Review which brought Catherine-de-Barnes into the Parish in April 2019, makes it necessary to carry out a more comprehensive review of the current Plan to take account of this change.

I write to ask for your help in influencing the revised Plan by completing the enclosed important Questionnaire which will assist us greatly in knowing the views and opinions of residents on a variety of matters which affect us all and which will guide building developments and community services in our area for many years to come. This Questionnaire represents a vital step in a wide ranging consultation process to identify how you would wish to see the villages meet future housing, employment and business needs- and vital public services like transport, schools, recreation, education and shops.

Also enclosed is information about the Neighbourhood Plan process and how it is developed for public scrutiny and adoption. Please note that the Questionnaire, which I do hope all residents (households) and businesses (a separate document) will complete, is entirely confidential and will be used to gather statistics only. SECTION A - HOUSING

Before completing this section please read the following note:

The Local Development Plan for Solihull (also currently under review, suggests over 11,000 new homes should be built in the Borough between now and 2028. Our Parish could well be asked to accept approaching 800 houses on 3 sites within the Parish (110 off Lapwing Drive, 600+ off Lugtrout Lane and 80+ at Oak Farm- Catherine de Barnes). It is intended that a proportion of these new homes will be 'affordable' either for outright sale, sale on a shared ownership basis (part buy, part rent), for rental or a mixture of all three. The need for affordable housing is recognised as being of great importance to very many people and is a primary concern of the Parish Council and others.

To help identify the level of need and to assist in completing this questionnaire, affordable housing is defined as follows:

Social rented and affordable rented housing – is owned and let by the council and housing associations at rents which are usually below market rents in the private sector.

Shared ownership (also known as Homebuy) – is designed for people who cannot afford to buy a house on the open market but still want to get on the property ladder. An initial share is bought using a traditional mortgage, usually between 25% and 75% of the total price depending on financial circumstances and a rent is paid on the remaining part. It may be possible to increase the share owned later. This is known as staircasing. When a shared ownership property is sold, the proceeds are split according to who owns what. In a restricted villages or rural area such as ours, it is not usually possible to buy 100% of a home outright and properties are normally only available for people with a local connection.
