An effective SACRE is generally aware of issues related to pupils' progress in RE (teachers from schools to come and talk to SACRE about the implementation of the agreed syllabus, provision and progress and attainment measures).

An effective SACRE advises schools as to specific places of worship that will enhance and support the taught curriculum.
