The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Bryanston Road and Streetsbrook Road, Solihull) (Total Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2025

The Council has made this Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004 and the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Solihull) Order 2007, where applicable, and all other enabling powers. The reasons for this Order can be obtained by written request from the address below; or by inspecting the documents at Solihull Connect, Library Square, Touchwood, Solihull during normal opening hours or via <https://www.solihull.gov.uk/Roads-pavements-and-streetcare//Traffic-regulation-orders>. A copy of the Order is available upon request. Anyone wishing to question the validity or provisions of the Order should apply to the High Court within six weeks from the date that the Order became effective. The Order, which comes into force on 27 March 2026, will introduce the following:

Total Prohibition of Waiting (No Waiting at Any Time)

Bryanston Road (both sides) - From its junction with Streetsbrook Road Service Road, north-eastwards for approx. 28m.

Streetsbrook Road Service Road (fronting 283 to 347) (both sides) - From a point approx. 17m north-west of its junction with Bryanston Road, south-eastwards from approx. 93m to its southern junction with Streetsbrook Road.

Streetsbrook Road (north-eastern) - From a point 39m north-west of its junction with Beaumont Grove in a north-westerly direction for approx. 96m.
