The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Fulford Hall Road and Dewberry Road, Tidbury Road) (Total Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2026

The Council has made this Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004 and the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Solihull) Order 2007, where applicable, and all other enabling powers. The reasons for this Order can be obtained by written request from the address below; or by inspecting the documents at Solihull Connect, Library Square, Touchwood, Solihull during normal opening hours or via <https://www.solihull.gov.uk/Roads-pavements-and-streetcare//Traffic-regulation-orders>. A copy of the Order is available upon request. Anyone wishing to question the validity or provisions of the Order should apply to the High Court within six weeks from the date that the Order became effective. The Order, which comes into force on 27 March 2026, will introduce the following:

Total Prohibition of Waiting (No Waiting at Any Time)

Fulford Hall Road (both sides) - from a point approx. 40m north of its junction with Dewberry Road, southwards for approx. 56m.

Dewberry Road (both sides) - from its junction with Fulford Hall Road, eastwards for approx. 30m.

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
