The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Hampton Lane, Lugtrout Lane and Bickenhill Lane, Solihull) (Total Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2026

The Council has made this Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004 and the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Solihull) Order 2007, where applicable, and all other enabling powers. The reasons for this Order can be obtained by written request from the address below; or by inspecting the documents at Solihull Connect, Library Square, Touchwood, Solihull during normal opening hours or via <https://www.solihull.gov.uk/Roads-pavements-and-streetcare//Traffic-regulation-orders>. A copy of the Order is available upon request. Anyone wishing to question the validity or provisions of the Order should apply to the High Court within six weeks from the date that the Order became effective. The Order, which comes into force on 27 March 2026, will introduce the following:

Total Prohibition of Waiting (No Waiting at Any Time)

Bickenhill Lane (both sides) - From its junction with Hampton Lane, northwards for approx. 17m.

Hampton Lane (north side) - From a point approx. 13m west of its junction with Lugtrout Lane, eastwards for approx. 43m.

Hampton Lane (north-west side) - From a point approx. 23m north-east of its junction with Bickenhill Lane, south-westwards for approx. 123m.

Hampton Lane (south-east side) - From a point approx. 23m north-east of its junction with Bickenhill Lane, south-westwards for approx. 115m.

Lugtrout Lane (west side) - From its junction with Hampton Lane, northwards for approx. 47m.

Lugtrout Lane (east side) - From its junction with Hampton Lane, northwards for approx. 52m.
