The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Lyndon Area, Solihull) (Designation of Blue Badge Holder Parking Places Total Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2026

Statement of Reasons

Motorists are parking in the Lyndon area of the Borough beside junctions & bends. The parking is interfering with motorist's sight lines and is detrimental to road safety.

Vehicles parking on the northern end of Keswick Road, near the A45 Coventry Road, are creating an obstruction due to the reduced road width.

Requests have also been received to increase the formal blue badge parking provision beside the parade of shops outside 247-261 & 254-260 Lyndon Road.

It is proposed to introduce double yellow lines: -

- Beside the following junctions: Marcot Road/Wichnor Road, Wagon Lane/Wells Green Road, Keswick Road/Wells Green Road.
- Beside the severe bends on Wells Green Road at residential frontages 31-39a & 97-125.
- In the cul-de-sac section of Wells Green Road (frontages 97-125) & on Keswick Road (between Coventry Road & Wells Green Road) to prevent parked vehicles creating an obstruction due to the restricted road width.

It is proposed to install a Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) to introduce two disabled bays outside 254 & 255 Lyndon Road. This will encourage, and aid, blue badge holders to utilise the shops.

It is recommended that proposals are advertised as shown on drawing no.'s 9605/1 & 9606/1.

The local ward members for Lyndon are aware of the proposed TRO.
