The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Yew Tree Lane, Solihull) (Total Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 2025

The Council has made this modified Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004 and the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Solihull) Order 2007, where applicable, and all other enabling powers. The reasons for this Order can be obtained by written request from the address below; or by inspecting the documents at Solihull Connect, Library Square, Touchwood, Solihull during normal opening hours or via <https://www.solihull.gov.uk/Roads-pavements-and-streetcare//Traffic-regulation-orders>. A copy of the Order is available upon request. Anyone wishing to question the validity or provisions of the Order should apply to the High Court within six weeks from the date that the Order became effective. The Order, which comes into force on 27 March 2026, will introduce the following:

Total Prohibition of Waiting (No Waiting at Any Time)

Yew Tree Lane (west side) - From a point approx. 24m from its northern boundary with 63 Yew Tree Lane, southwards for approx. 10m.

Restriction of Waiting - Monday to Saturday 8.00am to 6.00pm (Waiting Limited to 3 Hours – No Return Within 2 Hours)

Yew Tree Lane (west side) - From its northern boundary with 63 Yew Tree Lane, southwards for approx. 24m, and from a point approx. 34m from its northern boundary of 63 Yew Tree Lane southwards for approx. 21m.
