The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Various Roads in Solihull) (20 MPH Maximum Speed Limit) Order 2026

The Council proposes to make this Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, and all other enabling powers. The proposals are:

Proposed Maximum 20mph Speed Limit (at all times)

Chelmsley Wood

Woodlands Way - Entire length.

Dorridge & Hockley Heath

Avenue Road - From its junction with Dorridge Road, north-eastwards for approx. 115m.

Dorridge Road - From its junction with Avenue Road, south-eastwards for approx. 45m.

Grange Road - From its junction with Station Road, southwards to a point approx. 21m north of its junction with Forest Road.

Mill Lane - From a point approx. 31m west of its junction with Widney Road, westwards for approx. 536m.

Station Road - From its junction with Grange Road, northwards to a point approx. 180m southwest of its junction with Grove Road/Widney Road (roundabout).

The entire lengths of: Beckford Croft, Clifford Road, Copstone Drive, Dasset Road, Edstone Road, Enderby Close, Fennis Close, Forest Road, Hanbury Road, Hartlebury Close, Nuthurst Grove, Poplar Road and Station Approach.

Shirley West

Aqueduct Road - From its junction with Green Lane, northwards for approx. 270m.

Green Lane - From its junction with Aqueduct Road, eastwards for approx. 140m.

Shirley South

The entire lengths of: Cranmore Avenue, Cranmore Drive and Arleston Way.

Silhill

School Lane - From its junction with Hampton Lane, northwest wards for approx. 306m.

Bushell Drive - Entire length.

Proposed Revocation and Consolidation of Existing Maximum 20mph Speed Limits

To facilitate the above, all existing part-time and full time maximum 20mph speed limits pertaining to the above roads, where applicable, shall be either revoked and/or consolidated into this Order.
