## Frankholmes Drive, Monkspath - Proposed Traffic Calming Measures (Raised Table) and Establishment of New Parallel Crossing

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Council, in accordance with Section 90A of the Highways Act 1980 and in accordance with Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police, intends to construct the following traffic calming measures and commission new Parallel Crossing facilities at the locations specified below:
