I want to go into employment

Apprenticeship

A job where you get paid and learn new skills. You can earn qualifications while you work.



Inclusive Apprenticeship

A paid job for young people with SEND. You learn new skills and get extra support.



Employment

You have a job and get paid for your work.



Or, before that, I want to Stay in school



A-levels

Study 3-4 subjects of your choice at College or Sixth Form for 2 years.



Certificate, Diploma or Degree

Study for 3-5 years at University and get qualifications.

Gain new practical skills before going to university or work



Vocational qualifications

You learn skills for a job and get qualifications.



Inclusive pre-apprenticeship

Young people with SEND learn work skills and get support before starting an apprenticeship.



BTEC

You learn skills for a job, complete coursework, and gain qualifications at College or Sixth Form.



T Levels

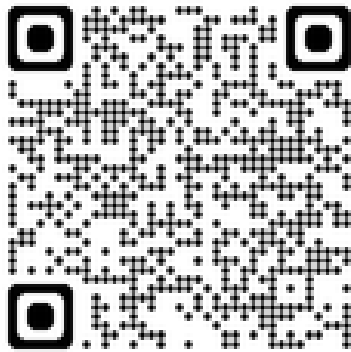
Most of the time you learn in College or Sixth Form but you also get work experience. You get qualifications.

Starting in September 2027. Like an A Level or T Level.
