### Statement of Evidence for Path Claim SAP4/5

- Both ends of the original path (from Warwick Road to Streetsbrook Road) were created by the Solihull Inclosure Award 1843, the north-east end being footway No.10, and the southern half being footway No.11. (Held by Warwickshire County Record Office at QS75/102.)
- The northern part of this path was diverted over a narrow accommodation bridge when the railway was constructed.
- This diverted route is shown on the first edition of the Ordnance Survey six inch map (1888), the north-east half being shown as a lane, or road, and the southern half as a footpath labelled 'FP'.
- The deposited plans for the proposed widening of the railway, in 1903, shows the same route of the path, which is marked as item 30 at the railway. The Book of Reference describes this item as "occupation road, footpath and bridge over railway", with the owners including Solihull Parish Council. (Held by WCRO at QS111/557.)
- The southern half of the path (up to the accommodation road) was closed by diversion onto proposed estate roads by a Quarter Sessions Highways Order of 10 May 1938. (Held by WCRO at QS47/367 (Mich. 1938).)
- Part of the length of the remaining path, known as 'Wadleys Road', was closed by the Stopping up of Highways (Warwickshire) (No.12) Order 1957, the Order being made under the Town and Country Planning Act 1947 on 30 August 1957. It is assumed this was the section west from Bryanston Road. (Advertisement in London Gazette No.41163 p.5103 (S.I. 1443).)
- The remaining path, namely over the railway, has a well maintained tarmac surface with cycle barriers and concrete street lights. There is also a 'no dog fouling' sign and a telegraph pole on the route.
- It is considered, therefore, that it is reasonable to allege that the route subsists as a public footpath and should be recorded as such on the Definitive Map.
