Statement of Evidence for Path Claim SAP 9

- The eastern half of the original route, and the south-west end, were created by the Solihull Inclosure Award 1843, the east half being awarded as footway No.12 and the south-west end as footway No.23. (Held by the Warwickshire County Record Office at QS75/102.)
- The whole of this route is shown, and labelled 'FP', on the first edition of the Ordnance Survey six inch map (1888).
- The south-west half of the path was diverted onto the proposed estate roads (Ralph Road, Arnold Road and Jacey Road) with a footpath link from the Stratford Road to the bend in Ralph Road by a Quarter Sessions Highways Order of Easter 1935/Easter 1936. (Held by WCRO at QS47/347.)
- Part of the path from Jacey Road to Prospect Road was diverted by The Stopping up of Highways (Warwickshire) (No.3) Order 1950, made on 10 July 1950. (Advert in London Gazette No.38983 p.3956 (S.I. 1123).)
- It is assumed that the route shown on the Ordnance Survey Pathfinder sheet 934 of 1986, namely turning north, through Palmers Rough, is the result of this Order, due to the development of Rothwell Drive.
- The path link created in 1935/6 generally has a good, tarmac, surface with concrete bollards two points, street lighting, a CATV manhole cover and a litter bin. The Palmers Rough section crosses playing fields and uses a track through a section of woodland.
- It is considered, therefore, that it is reasonable to allege that both sections subsist as public footpaths and should be recorded as such on the Definitive Map.
