Statement of Evidence for Path Claim SAP 80

- The original route, from Streetsbrook Road to Prospect Lane, is shown on the first edition of the Ordnance Survey six inch map as a narrow lane (1880's).
- 2 It is shown on the 1/25,000 Ordnance Survey sheet SP18 Birmingham (east) of 1951 (1977) as an uncoloured narrow lane.
- It is believed that the route is referred to as a public footpath from Streetsbrook Road to Prospect Lane (being the termination of the diverted path) in the Stopping up of Highways (Warwickshire) (No.3) Order 1950 made under the Town and Country Planning Act 1947. (Advert in the London Gazette No.38983 p.3956 (S.I. 1123).)
- 4 Most of the path was closed by diversion onto a new estate road (Nebworth Close) with a short footpath link, by the Borough of Solihull Public Path, Palmers Rough, Shirley Diversion Order 1961. (Adverts in London Gazette No.42401 p.4869 and No.42452 p.6437.)
- The remaining path has a good, tarmac, surface with various street lights along its length and has another footpath link off it onto the housing estate which was the subject of the 1950 Order.
- It is considered, therefore, that it is reasonable to allege that the route subsists as a public footpath and should be recorded as such on the Definitive Map.
