Meeting Housing Needs Supplementary Planning Document Adoption Statement

In accordance with Regulation 14 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 the Meeting Housing Needs Supplementary Planning Document was adopted by Solihull Council on 3rd July 2014.

A number of modifications were made to the draft supplementary planning document (February 2014) pursuant of Section 23(1) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004. These have been incorporated into the final Supplementary Planning Document Meeting Housing Needs. A list of modifications is appended.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the supplementary planning document may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for a judicial review of that decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the supplementary planning document was adopted (3rd July 2014).
