



Solihull Heat Network drop-in session

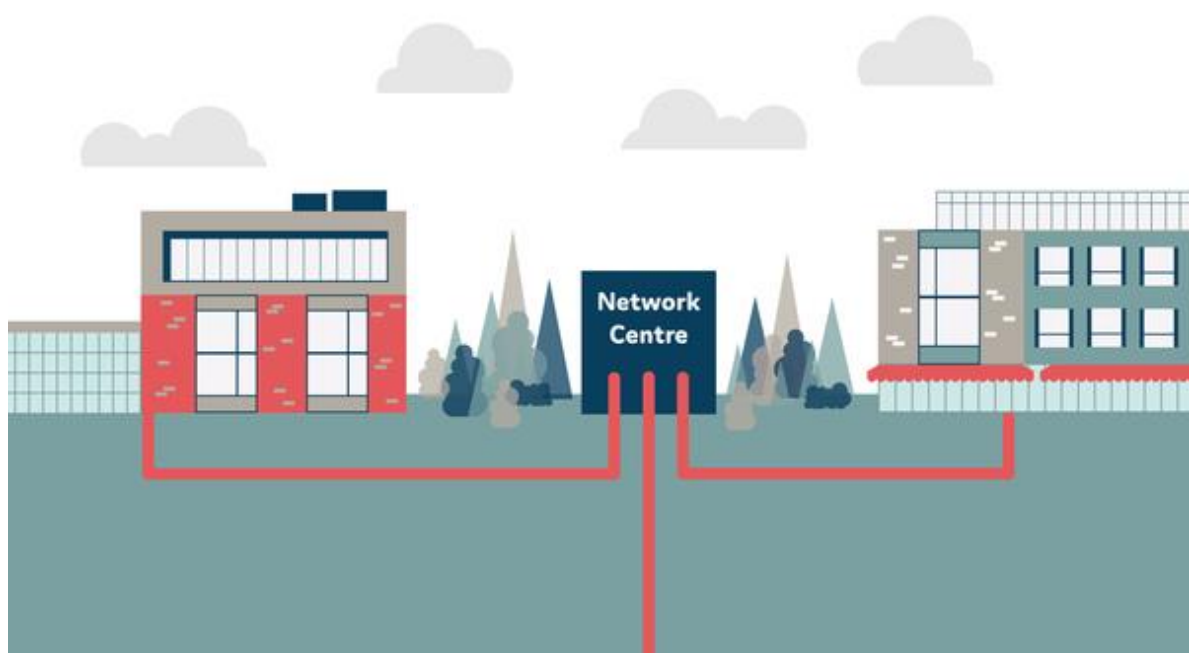
Thank you for signing up to receive regular updates on Solihull's exciting new heat network project.

As part of our initial feasibility study a test borehole will be drilled in Tudor Grange Park, work is expected to start 7 January 2019.

The test borehole will investigate what groundwater flows may be available from the water-bearing rock (aquifer) beneath Tudor Grange Park, with the aim of identifying a renewable ground source energy to feed heat into the network.

The investigation work will require a drilling rig to be set up and for drilling to be undertaken over a four week period. There will be minimal impact on car parking at Tudor Grange.

Officers from our UK Central team will be holding an informal drop-in session tomorrow (20 December) from 10am – 4pm in Tudor Grange Leisure Centre. Pop in to find out more about the project and its potential benefits for the town centre.
