Tidbury Green School



Expansion Proposal:

In May 2016, the Council approved the updated School Organisation Plan for Solihull which outlined the need to add additional primary school places due to an increasing birth rate, population growth and housing developments.

Tidbury Green School, judged to be a good school by Ofsted, is the Council's preferred location to meet the demand from parents moving to the new housing being built on Braggs Farm; Cleobury Lane; Lowbrook Farm and Tidbury Green Farm.

The School currently has capacity for 315 pupils (45 in each year group) plus 30 part-time nursery pupils. Under this proposal the school would expand to a capacity of 420 pupils (60 in each year group) from September 2018 and over time up to 60 part-time nursery pupils.

Although the capacity of the school is 315, it has been operating with one form of entry in each year group and at October 2016 the school had 217 pupils on roll.


